

1. On March 20, the Oklahoma State School Board voted to suspend all school activities until April 6<sup>th</sup>. These activities include educational activities and all extra-curricular activities and meetings. No school facilities will be open or available to anyone, students or adults, until the State Department of Education gives schools clearance to resume.
2. Other scheduled events such as testing, field trips, banquets, and prom will be rescheduled if possible, but rescheduling will depend on available time when schools are released from the shut-down. The community will be notified through One-Call and various web sites when any dates are finalized.
3. Administrative offices will be open from 8:00 to 3:00 for phone calls, but in person meetings will only be allowed if the Principal or Superintendent schedules the meeting. Office employees will be answering the telephone so please use the telephone or email for questions or other requests for information. Custodians and aides will report for work on Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>.
4. We will work with the Child Nutrition offices in the SDE to provide a “Grab and Go” sack lunch for students who need a noon meal. Lunches will be available outside the back door of the school cafeteria. If your children need a noon meal we ask that you call the grade school office, 580-652-2463 so the cooks can prepare enough meals. All meals will be governed by regulations from the Child Nutrition office and are only for Hooker students.
5. Teachers may have access to their classrooms, but the school district will not require any meetings, assignments or grading during the closure.
6. Required Federal meetings, such as IEP meetings may be conducted by phone or video if parties are agreeable to it. Parents will be contacted by the appropriate personnel to schedule meetings.
7. Release to reopen schools will be re-examined on March 25<sup>th</sup> by the State Board of Education. The State School Board will review available data on status of viral infections in the state and make a decision to reopen schools or possibly extend the closing for an additional period of time.
8. Classroom teachers and custodians have sanitizing wipes and sprays available for use in the classrooms, cafeteria and bathrooms. We will continue to do everything we can to ensure that everyone does proper hand washing. These are things we already do each year during flu season and we will remain vigilant in keeping the buildings as germ-free as possible.
