

Hooker JH/HS will be going to distance learning for the remainder of the school week (December 1-4). THIS IS ONLY FOR THE JH/HS. THE ELEMENTARY WILL CONTINUE IN PERSON SCHOOL. This decision is due to shortage of staff at the JH/HS.

Please note the following...

Roll/Attendance will be taken for every period/subject (each of the 7 classes).

To be counted present, these two things need to be done...

- Go to Google Classroom daily, and answer the bell ringer question (for all seven classes). The bell ringer needs to be done by 1:00 pm daily.
- Work on the assignments, given by the teachers, and turn in the assignments on the due dates.

Students can be counted absent if the two previous requirements are not done each school day.

If a student would be too sick to do the Google Classroom assignments, they will need a parent to call them in sick to the JH/HS office (652-2516). Without doing the assignments or a call in sick, the student will be counted absent from school. Calling the office to report a student absence would also apply to a student being gone for a doctor's appointment, funeral, etc. *If the student signs in, does the bell ringer and Google Classroom work, they will be counted present at school. UNEXCUSED absences can be given if the work is not done AND a parent/guardian does not call the student in absent to the office.*

School lunches

On the distance learning days, lunch will still be served for the JH/HS students. Meals can be picked up at the back door of the cafeteria from 10:40 am-1:00 pm. If a student would like a meal, you must contact the elementary office (652-2463). Please call by 9:00 am. If you have further questions concerning meals, please contact the elementary office.

For summary of the distance days

- Students must get on Google Classroom and do both the bell ringer and homework daily for all seven classes. If not, they will be counted absent. Without a call from the parent/guardian, the absence can be unexcused.
- If a student can not access Google Classroom by computer, tablet, or cell phone, you need to contact the JH/HS office (652-2516) and alternative arrangements will be made.
- Grades for assignments will be determined based on the work turned in for those assignments. Students can be given zeros for work not turned in.
